# One-on-one individualised care for people living with dementia and their care partners

Presbyterian Support Northern (PSN) is starting a new fee-paying service aimed at improving the quality of life for people living with dementia and their carers in the Waikato and Auckland regions.

The initiative is run by PSN's Enliven health and disability service and recognises the growing number of people with dementia and their caregivers and families.

We want to help people stay in their homes and communities for as long as possible.

The aim of the service is to provide quality care that maximises the quality of life for people with dementia, carers and families at an affordable cost.

## About the Enliven individualised dementia care service

Enliven has a team of registered nurses and occupational therapists who are passionate about working with people with dementia and their families.

We work alongside clients and their carers throughout their dementia pathway, striving to provide stable, supportive, high quality services through a qualified professional workforce.

Our approach begins with a thorough assessment centred around individual needs, challenges and presenting symptoms.

We honour the person's life before dementia, and use this knowledge to ensure a wrap-around service is in place to give clients the quality of life they deserve.

Enliven's programme of support is aimed at people living with mild to moderate dementia, as well as their carers and families.







### Health and disability services

#### **PRICING MODEL**

At Enliven, our approach is unique and centred around helping those with dementia to continue living at home. We believe in prioritising safety and independence, while maintaining a high quality of life.

This is a flexible, individually tailored service and there will be various packages available at different prices depending on the level of support needed.

However, at this stage of the new service we recommend the following package:



### Assessment and Planning: \$350

#### **Includes:**

- Being personally matched with a dementia specialised healthcare professional
- Medical and life history review
- Assessments of environmental criteria, quality of life and individual challenges
- Creation of an individualised dementia plan.

#### Monthly Subscription: \$1140 per month

Includes a menu of services that will be discussed with you at the initial assessment and planning, for example:

- Navigator service to help you orientate the healthcare system
- Education and support regarding your journey with dementia
- 12 hours of one-on-one care comprising:
  - · Enhancement of safety in the home environment
  - · Support to manage behaviours which challenge
  - · Provision of cognitive reablement and stimulation activities
  - · Engagement in meaningful activities
  - · Establishing a stable routine
  - · Assistance in connecting socially with others
  - · Supporting carers to look after their loved ones
  - · Functional support
  - · Ongoing assessment, advocacy and reporting as required.

**Note:** this service is initially provided on an eight-week basis. The service and what you think of it, will then be assessed and your input sought with a view to widen the service if needed.
